He established and maintained the delicate balance between clear, comprehensive communication with program personnel and secure, protected confidentiality for LDAC constituents. He is a superb team player and a great delegator.
3. Chaplain Kim demonstrates a genuine gift of kindness, an encouraging spirit, and a love for Soldiers and Army Families. He preached for a garrison Sunday Worship Service, counseled 16 Cadets, Cadre and Chaplain Assistants, and ministered in an unusual and timely fashion by providing haircuts for several UMT personnel. He also supervised 5 Field Services as backup Chaplain Trainer. His 10 years ordained pastoral experience, 15 years as Missionary Trainer, and his two units of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) make him value-added to the Army and contributed greatly to the overwhelming success of our religious support mission.
